Dear Parents,

I trust that Term 3 has started positively and that your son/daughter has settled well back in to the routines of school. We have been delighted to see our students approaching their learning with such enthusiasm and focus.

As you would now be aware, the 'In Time Reporting' process has been implemented in earnest this year and we have received some very positive feedback from parents who are appreciating the regular updates on student performance and constructive feedback on future learning from teaching staff. If you have not yet logged on to the Parent Portal (SEQTA Engage), I encourage you to do so to check the most up to date assessments and feedback. It is our intention to provide both student feedback and feedback to parents on a more regular basis, as we know that this impacts the learning process in a positive way and allows us all to work together in supporting our students. Parents are now receiving regular personalised communications regarding student progress and personal learning via the 'In Time Reporting' process and thus the summative 'Semester Report, was prepared and delivered in a condensed format.

We anticipate that for the majority of parents, the 'In Time Reporting' will have provided the information needed to establish a good understanding of how your child is progressing. If, however, you wish to further discuss the results within the summative Semester 1 Report, or to discuss the progress of your son/daughter with teaching staff, Learning Conferences will be conducted between **4pm to 6pm** and **6.30pm to 8pm** on: **Thursday 18th August**. Learning Conferences run for 10 minutes in duration, however if any parent requires a longer conference time, please discuss this with the relevant teacher prior to your selected time-slot.

**Please note:** We are asking all students to accompany their parents as part of our Learning Conference process. Research suggests that student learning can be impacted positively through the teacher providing direct feedback to individual students. It also provides opportunity for reflection, questions and discussion pertinent to goal setting. We feel that parents will also benefit from these opportunities for discussion and feedback.
