Year 4 - 9 Geelong House Athletics & Sport Activity Day

Dear Parents,

This year's House Athletics and Sports Activity Day to be held on Wednesday 29th March aims to involve all students from Year 4 to Year 9. The College believes participation in House competition is an integral part of the school sport program and asks all parents to support us in our aim of having all students participate.

Event: Geelong Year 4 - 9 House Athletics & Sport Activity Day

Venue: Middle School - Highton

Date: Wednesday 29th March

Uniform: All students are to wear College sports uniform (with House polo) to school on the day. House polo and navy shorts are to be worn whilst competing and all students must have their hats.

Program:

The House Athletics & Sport Activity Day is designed to provide students with the opportunity to be engaged in a variety of track, field, initiative and house based activities. The program includes House Novelty events for students who are not competing in the final of the High Jump, Discus, Shot Put and Long Jump events. Trials have been held in Physical Education and Sport to determine the top 10 students for these finals. Non-finalists participate in initiative and team activities with their house groups, with all results going toward their house's tally. Throughout the day, Year 8 & 9 students will have the opportunity to work with and mentor Year 4 & 5 students respectively. Every student's results, including results from trials during Physical Education and Sport, contributes points toward their house's tally. In addition, the top 12 place getters within each event record individual points toward their personal tally to determine the year level champion. At the conclusion of the day a House Winner is awarded and following full analysis of all results, which does take considerable time, the year level champions will be presented at the first assembly next term.

Information:

- Parents are most welcome to attend. Parent assistance with the running of the event is also greatly appreciated. If you are available to assist, please contact Renee Garing directly via email.

It is expected that without written notification of injury or illness prior to or on the day your Son/Daughter will participate in all events.
- Performances in track & field events are used to assist with the selection of representative teams who compete at Deakin District (Year 4 – 6) and GISSA (Year 7 – 9) Athletic events.
- Students need to bring their own food and drink for the day. It is recommended that students have a water bottle with them during competition. Students will not be able to purchase from the Canteen on this day.
- Students are expected to have any required medication (ie.Ventolin) on them at all times. A qualified first aid person will be in attendance.
- Please note; the driveway at the Burdekin Road entrance will be blocked off from the front car park, to the start of the College roundabout from 9.00am – 4.00pm. Access to the car park at the front of the school can still be gained by entering via the main gates on Burdekin Road. If you need to access the main office at Middle School or the back of the school by car, please enter via our entry on Thornhill Road.
- Students are not to bring their laptops to school on the Athletics Day. If the event is cancelled for any reason, an email will be sent out to all parents that morning to request students to bring books and laptops.
