Dear Middle School Student and Parent,

The 2017 Salvation Army Red Shield Doorknock will take place on Sunday, 28th May.

Over the past 20 years Christian College Geelong have developed a tradition of lending our support to this appeal which supports local and overseas people in need. By giving of a small amount of our time, we can raise a significant amount to assist others less fortunate than ourselves.

Time and Meeting place

All collectors are to meet at **10.00 a.m. at the Middle School Sports and Aquatic Centre** on Thornhill Road, Highton. Parents are asked to accompany their children into the upstairs foyer to sign their child in.

Collection Areas

This year, Christian College has been allocated three areas in Highton, each of which is adjacent to the Middle School Campus in Burdekin Road. Both Senior School and Middle School Highton students, staff and parents will be collecting in these areas.

Collecting Groups

Within each area, we hope to have several groups of four students collecting in pairs on either side of a particular street. An adult staff member or parent will provide transport to the start of the collection area, remain in the area for support and then provide transport back to Middle School.

If any parents would like to participate, either as transport or to accompany a group, your support would be greatly appreciated. We will require an adult to be a collector with all of our groups of Year 5 and 6 students.

All parent volunteers must complete a **CCG Volunteer Form** (attached) and we will need to collect a copy of your **Working with Children Card**.

If scarves or gloves are worn please ensure that they are plain navy. Remember that you are representing our school in the neighbourhood.
